Kyle Ayers is an Emergency Room Technician at Los Robles Regional Medical Center in Thousand Oaks, CA. He grew up in Newbury Park and graduated from Thousand Oaks High School in 2003. Kyle has worked as a first responder for eight years; prior to his career at Los Robles, he worked as an EMT for PRN Ambulance. He is a CPR instructor at Code 3 Life in Camarillo and is a pre-nursing student at Moorpark College.

In August of 2020, Kyle contracted Guillain Barre Syndrome. He spent August and September in the ICU at Los Robles Hospital and continues to be paralyzed. He has many months of therapy and rehabilitation ahead of him.

Guillain-Barré syndrome is a neurological condition where the body's immune response attacks the nerves, resulting in rapid paralysis and, in severe cases, loss of breathing. He has been in a hospital bed since Aug. 2, and Ryan Ayers said his brother's recovery will require up to a year of specialists, specialty care facilities and rehabilitation centers. Even with insurance, Ryan Ayers said, the costs pile up. Kyle's family and friends appreciate being a recipient to this year's virtual ride. This is the strength Kyle needs to make a full recovery.
